OUR SCHOOL



- We cater for the needs of children between 7 and 1 years old
- ▶ 12 classes, 3 for each of the junior age range
- ▶ 48 languages other than English are spoken
- Work with other school via EPHA, ELC and HEP
- Teachers and support staff work closely together
- Inclusion Manager
- Clubs
- Parent Pay/school meals no longer free until on FSM
- Maintenance Fund
- We are very much a family that works together in partnership and work very closely with the neighbouring school; Tottenhall infants.

OUR SCHOOL DAY

- Breakfast club starts: 7.45 a.m.
- School starts: 8.30 a.m.
- Gates in the playground will open at 8.15 a.m.
- End of the school day: 3.15 p.m. (Mondays to Thursdays)
- School closes at 1.00 p.m. on FRIDAYS
- Super Stars Sports After School Club at Tottenhall3.15 p.m. 5.45 p.m.
- On Fridays, clubs run either by staff or outside agencies for pupils who need to remain on the premises until 3.15pm. There will be a charge for these, which will vary depending on the club (Between £5-£7)

OUR CURRICULUM & LEARNING

- We teach all the National Curriculum (2014) subjects
- Half termly topics. History and Geography led
- MFL French taught through iLanguages scheme
- Language of the term celebration of community languages
- Learning well scaffolded and supported to allow all pupils to thrive and make good progress from their starting points
- Interventions and challenge groups
- ▶ PE two hours per week. Additional sporting events throughout the year and sports clubs after school.
- Swimming Year 5
- Home learning. Some weekly (deliberate practice, prereading), some termly (projects and home learning grid)

- ► Well above National in Reading, Writing and Maths. Top 3% of primary schools in the country.
- SMAB performed extremely well in the overall performance table of 95 schools in Enfield at the end of KS2 SATS 2019
- ▶ 1st in Writing
- ▶ 2nd in Reading
- ▶ 3rd in Maths
