REPORTING YOUR CHILD'S ABSENCE

On the occasions of 'unavoidable absence' e.g. illness or emergencies, you are requested to inform the office by 9.00 a.m. on the first day of absence. Parents who do not follow this protocol will therefore be contacted by a member of the office staff requesting an explanation. If we are unable to contact you, your child's absence will remain unauthorised. If your child is unwell in the morning with a headache or tummyache and their condition improves, please bring them in for the afternoon session.

Where 'non-attendance in relation to coronavirus' applies We will only accept 'non-attendance in relation to coronavirus' in circumstances where a pupil's travel to, or attendance at, school would be:

- Against guidance from Public Health England and/or the Department of Health and Social Care relating to the incidence of coronavirus or its transmission
- Prohibited by any legislation or statutory directions relating to the incidence of transmission of coronavirus

Pupil develops symptoms or lives with someone who does The pupil's parent/carer must notify the school on the first day that their child needs to **SELF ISOLATION**. The pupil will stay at home until they or the symptomatic person they live with receives their coronavirus test results.

Pupil or a 'close contact' of theirs receives a **POSITIVE TEST** result. The pupil's parent/carer must notify the school about the positive test result as soon as possible. Either call the school office 020 8888 6100, email office@smab.enfield.sch.uk or via Class Dojo.
