

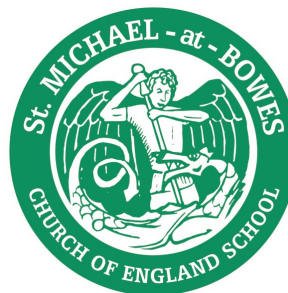

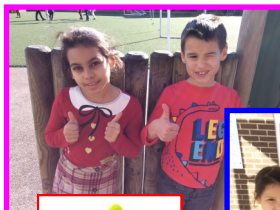

Thank you to everyone for their generous contributions, we managed to raise **£288.64** for Comic relief.

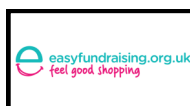

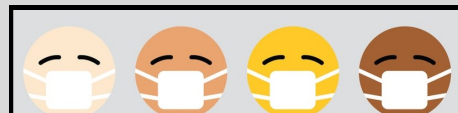
