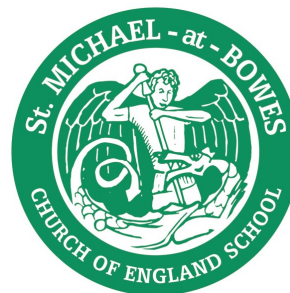

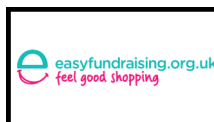
### VIRTUAL COFFEE MORNING

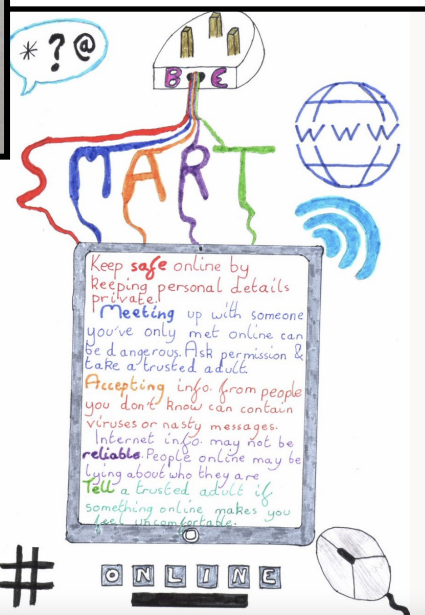
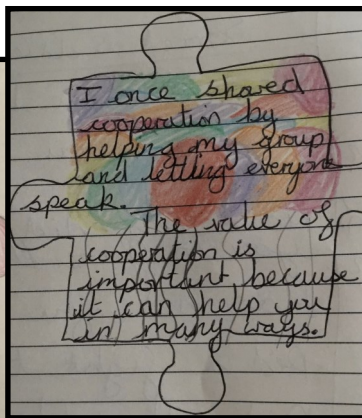
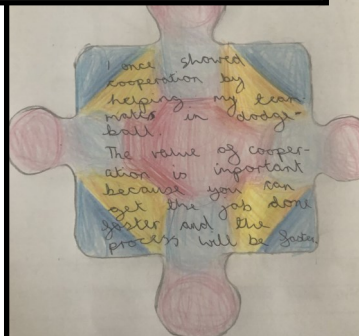
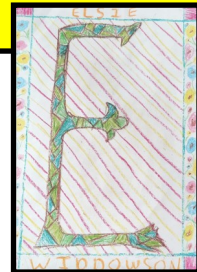
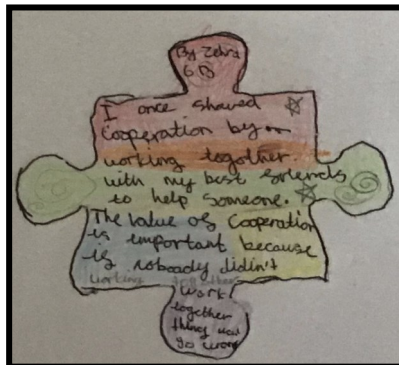


## HALF TERM ACTIVITIES



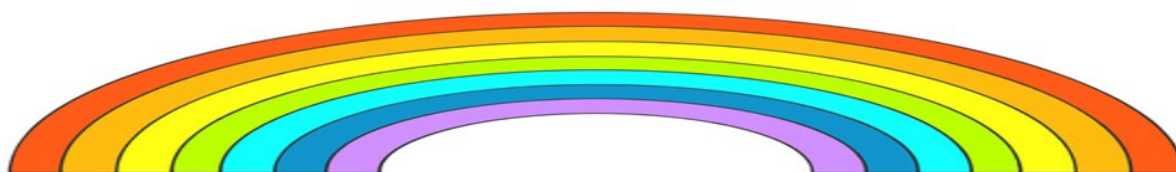

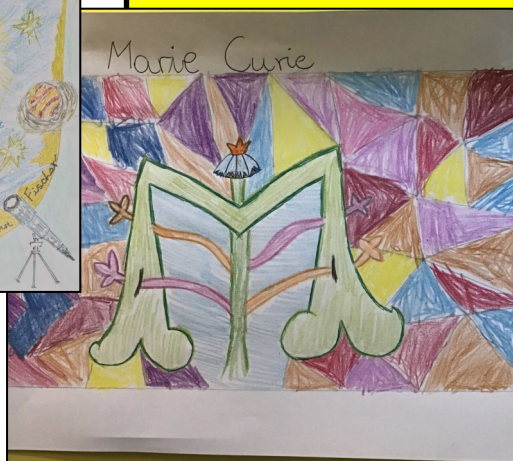
# SMAB REMOTE LEARNING
