These are the current recommended guidelines to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses:

*washing your hands often - with soap and water, or use alcohol sanitiser if handwashing facilities are not available. This is particularly important after taking public transport

*covering your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throwing the tissue in a bin. See Catch it, Bin it, Kill it

*people who feel unwell should stay at home and should not attend work or any education or childcare setting

*pupils, students, staff and visitors should wash their hands:

before leaving home on arrival at school after using the toilet after breaks and sporting activities before food preparation before eating any food, including snacks before leaving school

*use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available

*avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands

*avoid close contact with people who are unwell

*clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
