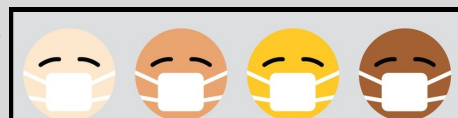
Please try to reinforce the values, Beatitudes and articles when talking to your child.
