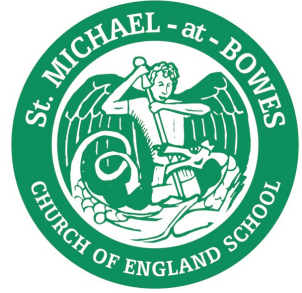

The gates will be open at 9.50 a.m. Please line up outside your child's Year 3 classroom.

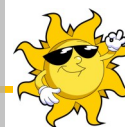
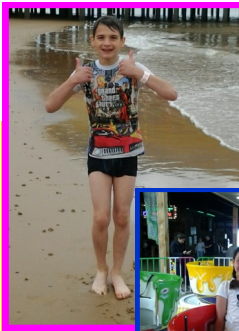
A short meeting will be held for parents in the hall at 10.00 am.
