
WORLD BOOK DAY

and bad sanitation is the second biggest child killer worldwide? A lack of clean water and toilets keeps girls out of school, stops women from working, and traps people in poverty.

As a result of this talk, the children in Year 5 have been inspired to raise money to help Water Aid with their numerous projects. As little as £10.00 will help to build a well in a village. The children hope to raise £1000.00 over the next year. Next week on Monday 14th March the children will start their fundraising activities with a cake sale after school, and this will be followed by "dress in blue" on Tuesday 22nd March which is World Water Day.
