Maths

Our maths work will include:

- Fractions
- Mental and written methods – addition and subtraction
- Number – Multiplication and Division
- Measurement
- Time

OUR TARGETS FOR THIS TERM ARE:

- I can add and subtract numbers mentally, including a three digit number and hundreds.
- I can recognise and show, using diagrams, equivalent fractions with small denominators.
- I can compare and order fractions with the same denominator.
