## LATE PICK UP

I would like to remind parents/carers that if your child is col-



lected late at the end of the school day or from an after school club on a regular basis you will be charged for late pick up; for every 15 minutes after school or after school activities have finished the rate will be £5 per 15 minutes thereafter to meet the cost of child-care/supervision.

If for whatever reason you are running late please call the school office to let us know as soon as possible. Late collection can be extremely stressful for your child.

**REMINDER:** The school day starts at **8.30 a.m.** The school gates in Grenoble gardens are open at **8.15 a.m.** and the bell rings at **8.25 a.m.** when children are allowed to walk to their classroom, a second bell goes at **8.30 a.m.** signalling the beginning of the school day. **Monday to Thursday** the school day ends at **3.15 p.m.** On **Fridays** the school day ends at **1.00 p.m.**

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
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## SCHOOL WEBSITE
