



WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY HELP POINT SCHEME?

CHiPS has been a network of 'safe havens' across the Borough of Enfield since 2006, where young & vulnerable people who are lost, at risk or feeling vulnerable can go in and ask for help & assistance from the community.

WHAT DO MEMBERS HAVE TO DO?

Members display the CHiPS 🖬 logo & can make a phone call to get assistance for someone, allow someone to sit in safety for a while until a risk has passed, give someone directions on how to get to their chosen destination, call the police, medical or social care teams.

WHO ARE CURRENTLY MEMBERS?
