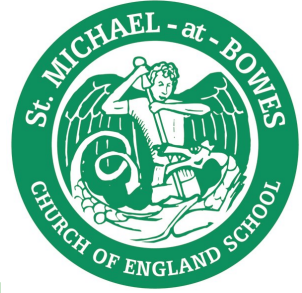

REPORTING YOUR CHILD'S ABSENCE
