#### **OUR SCHOOL**

- ▶ 12 classes, 3 for each of the junior age range
- ▶ 48 languages other than English are spoken
- ► Teachers and support staff work closely together

#### **OUR SCHOOL**

- ► Well above National in Reading, Writing and Maths. Top 3% of primary schools in the country.
- SMAB performed extremely well in the overall performance table of 95 schools in Enfield at the end of KS2 SATS 2019
- ▶ 1<sup>st</sup> in Writing
- ▶ 2<sup>nd</sup> in Reading
- ▶ 3<sup>rd</sup> in Maths



#### **OUR SCHOOL DAY**

- Breakfast club starts: 7.45 a.m.
- School starts: 8.30 a.m.
- Gates in the playground will open at 8.15 a.m.
- End of the school day: 3.15 p.m. (Mondays to Thursdays)
- School closes at 1.00 p.m. on <u>FRIDAYS</u>
- Grass Roots After School Club at Tottenhall 3.15 p.m. 5.45 p.m.
- On Fridays, clubs run either by staff or outside agencies for pupils who need to remain on the premises until 3.15pm. There will be a charge for these, which will vary depending on the club

#### **UNIFORM**

- Children are required to wear full uniform every day
- Black shoes and plimsolls for PE
- ▶ PE kit bags can be purchased from the uniform shop
- All items of clothing and personal property must be clearly labelled
- No Jewellery or nail varnish
- School uniform supplier in Wood Green
- Uniform sales and Open Day held in July
