OUR SCHOOL

- ▶ We cater for the needs of children between 7 and 11 years old
- ▶ 12 classes, 3 for each of the junior age range
- ▶ 48 languages other than English are spoken
- ▶ Teachers and support staff work closely together
- ▶ Inclusion Manager
- ▶ National Curriculum subjects + RE
- ▶ Clubs
- ▶ Parent Pay/school meals
- ▶ Maintenance Fund
- ▶ We are very much a family that works together in partnership and work very closely with the neighbouring school; Tottenham infants.



OUR SCHOOL

- ▶ **Well above National** in Reading, Writing and Maths. **Top 3% of primary schools in the country.**
- ▶ SMAB performed extremely well in the overall performance table of 95 schools in Enfield at the end of KS2 SATS 2019
- ▶ **1st** in Writing
- ▶ **2nd** in Reading
- ▶ **3rd** in Maths

OUR SCHOOL DAY

- ▶ Breakfast club starts: 7.45 a.m.
- ▶ School starts: 8.30 a.m.
- ▶ Gates in the playground will open at 8.15 a.m.
- ▶ End of the school day: 3.15 p.m. (**Mondays to Thursdays**)
- ▶ **School closes at 1.00 p.m. on FRIDAYS**
- ▶ Grass Roots After School Club at Tottenham 3.15 p.m. - 5.45 p.m.
- ▶ On Fridays, clubs run either by staff or outside agencies for pupils who need to remain on the premises until 3.15pm. There will be a charge for these, which will vary depending on the club

UNIFORM

- ▶ Children are required to wear full uniform every day
- ▶ Black shoes and plimsolls for PE
- ▶ PE kit - bags can be purchased from the uniform shop
- ▶ All items of clothing and personal property must be clearly labelled
- ▶ No Jewellery or nail varnish
- ▶ School uniform supplier in Wood Green
- ▶ Uniform sales and Open Day held in July

WORKING TOGETHER

- ▶ Aim to provide a happy and safe environment in our school, where effective learning can take place for all of our pupils
- ▶ Good behaviour is encouraged, valued and rewarded (Bragsters and Class Dojos)
- ▶ Work closely with home and school (Home Learning)

- ▶ Regular and punctual attendance
- ▶ Absence - The office must be notified giving the reason in writing or by phone call on the first day of absence
- ▶ Holidays not to be taken during term time - School may issue a fine

- ▶ Two or more applicants who have equal rights -

 2. Closest proximity to school
