
YEAR 6 BACK AT SMAB

Year 6 have been constructing rain gauges using recycled products to monitor our local climate and discussed the impact this may have on our ecosystems. We also explored human impact on climate and looked at trends over time. The final products were robust gauges, which were fit for their design brief, combining a variety of different materials.

Children also made 'paper Mache' models of endangered animals. Stripped pieces of recycled paper were soaked in water and then molded into the appropriate shapes. Once these dried out, children then painted them using a variety of colour mixes.

Finally they created a setting for the animals by either placing it amongst twigs, leaves and pieces of plastic, which represents the dangers that they face.
