OUR SCHOOL



- A family inclusive and welcoming of all
- ► 12 classes, 3 for each of the junior age range (7-11)
- ▶ 48 languages other than English are spoken
- Parent Pay/school meals no longer free unless on FSM
- Maintenance Fund £39 per child per year

OUR SCHOOL DAY

- Breakfast club starts: 7.45 a.m.
- School starts: 8.50 a.m.
- Gates in the playground will open at 8.30 a.m. and close at 9.00 a.m.
- Years 3 and 4 enter through Grenoble Gardens
- Years 5 and 6 enter through Tottenhall Road
- End of the school day: 3.20 p.m.
- Super Stars Sports After School Club at Tottenhall 3.20 p.m. - 5.45 p.m.

ATTENDANCE

- Regular and punctual attendance
- Absence The office must be notified giving the reason in writing or by phone call on the first day of absence
- Holidays not to be taken during term time - School may issue a fine

OUR CURRICULUM & LEARNING

- ▶ We teach all the National Curriculum (2014) subjects
