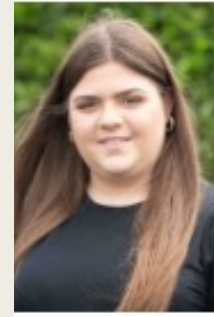

- Gates open at 8:40am – 8:50 min class so we can maximise learning time.

Reading

- 20 minutes every day - independently or ideally with a family member.
- Remember you can complete AR quizzes at home via the link on your child's class page on Microsoft Teams.
- Weekly comments in their Reading Record could be:
 - What they enjoyed;
 - Challenging words;
 - Prediction of what might happen next;
 - Something they have learnt from their book;
- Reading should be fun and we have a list of books perfect for Year 4 pupils.
- Listening to other people read is also great for developing comprehension and understanding of new vocabulary.

Multiplication and Division facts

- By the end of Year 4, all pupils need to know up to their 12 times tables.
- It is extremely important that the children learn their multiplication facts by and be able to recall them rapidly.
- In June, pupils will take a Government initiated times table test.
- Going on TT RockStars daily as well as Freckle weekly. Test your children at home to improve recall speed.

Home learning

- Complete your weekly Freckle task (this is a priority).
- If you don't have a device at home please speak to a member of the team to see if the school can support you with one.

Handwriting

- At SMAB, we encourage children to write using the *cursive style* of handwriting.
- There is a link on our website in order to help support your child.
- A letter will be handed out to you with login details.

Benefits:

- Overtime, pupils will write faster.
- Helps with spelling.
- Legible – important in school progression.
