Parent Feedback

Feedback was overwhelmingly positive with parents expressing that SMAB is one of the best schools. Most were very happy that their child attended the school and enjoyed being a part of the school community. A number of parents mentioned how grateful they were for the care, warmth and hard work of all staff. In response to comments made on questionnaires, we would like to clarify the following points:

- We aim to update our school website as often as possible. However, Class Dojo is being used as our main communication tool between school and home. We aim to send as few paper letters home as possible these tend to be limited to those letters that require a written response. Teachers, where practical, also use Dojo to send information about what is happening in class and to celebrate achievements, but we are mindful of staff workload and therefore this is not an expectation.
- The newsletter is an essential way the school keeps parents informed. It is extremely valuable and important for parents and has important dates such as class assemblies and upcoming events.
- The behaviour of children at SMAB is very good and has been commented on by outside agencies when reviewing the school and its work this year. When there are incidents of negative behaviour, we follow our behaviour policy consistently, which you can find on the school website. We believe that the most effective discipline is self-discipline and through our Behaviour Policy we have developed a framework to enable this to happen. The school alone cannot instil a framework of discipline into children. It is therefore essential that parents work closely together with the school. Parents / carers and pupils all have a duty to play an active role in ensuring that the school maintains an atmosphere in which all feel proud of their work and conduct.
- To enable parents to better support their child, we have, in the past, run workshops and events for parents. However, we have had very low attendance at these events.
- As a school, we provide feedback to children on a one-to-one basis. This is done during lessons and during conferencing with the class teacher once a week. This ensures that feedback is personal and meaningful for children.
- The school currently offers seven after school clubs. Some of these (FAB at SMAB, most sports clubs, Lego and Gardening) are free of charge. We are limited in the number of clubs we can run, due to lack of space

From the comments received and the percentages above, the school will be taking the following actions to address parent/carer views:

- We will send out a separate question regarding numbers of parents who would like school
 workshops to help support their child in their learning. If a reasonable number of parents would like
 to do this, we will resume running these next academic year.
- We will continue to improve our website by ensuring it is kept as up to date as possible.
